

Pre-seizure notice

This boat is declared a derelict vessel for the reason of:

The Vessel has been stored on Port property for several years – there is no agreement with the Port of Astoria to store this vessel on any Port property.

This boat is declared an abandoned vessel by reason of:

Being stored at 422 Gateway Ave without authorization for several years.

This boat **WILL BE SEIZED** by the enforcement agency, for being a derelict and abandoned vessel if the derelict condition of the vessel is not remedied and the boat is not moved to a place where it can be lawfully kept by:

Seizure date and time: June 27, 2016 at 8:00am

If the boat is seized, the owner of this boat is liable for the salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs of this vessel. If the owner does not pay the costs of salvage, towing and storage costs, title to this vessel will vest with the enforcement agency and the boat will be sold or destroyed. The owner will remain liable for any outstanding salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs.

The owner of this vessel has until the seizure date and time above to request a hearing to contest the validity of the proposed seizure. A request for hearing must be in writing, directed to the Enforcement Agency listed above, and must indicate if the owner contends that the vessel is not abandoned or derelict, or indicate such other specific grounds on which seizure of the vessel is challenged.

The owner of this boat may be cited for possession of a derelict vessel if the owner fails to remedy the derelict condition of the vessel by the seizure date and time above.

The owner of this boat may be cited for failure to remove an abandoned vessel if the owner fails to move the vessel to a place where the vessel can be lawfully kept by the seizure date and time above.
