RE: Pre-seizure notice for boat registered as Endurance

Dear Mr. Knowles,

The US Coast Guard Documentation records indicate that you are the current owner of a 1970 Steel sailing vessel, 52 feet in over all length, with the hull identification number of 30 and a US Coast Guard Documentation number of 655242. On Nov.30, 2018 your moorage license agreement was terminated due to non-payment of moorage at Port of Astoria Pier III Boatyard. Pursuant to state law, ORS 830.908, this boat is declared an abandoned vessel for the reason of being left moored at Port of Astoria Pier III Boatyard without payment or authorization. This boat is further declared an abandoned vessel by reason of remaining at Port of Astoria Pier III boat yard without authorization since November 30 2018.

This boat **WILL BE SEIZED** under the authority of ORS 830.911 by the Port of Astoria, for being a derelict and abandoned vessel if the derelict condition of the boat is not remedied **and the boat is not moved to a place where it can be lawfully kept by:**

Seizure date and time: December 14, 2018

If the boat is seized, you, as the owner of this boat, are liable for the salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs of this vessel. If you do not pay the costs of salvage, towing and storage costs, within 30 days of the seizure, title to this vessel will vest with the Port of Astoria and the boat will be sold or destroyed. You will remain liable for any outstanding salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs.

You have until the seizure date and time listed above to request a hearing to contest the validity of the proposed seizure. A request for hearing must be in writing, directed to the Enforcement Agency listed above, and must indicate if you contend that the vessel is not abandoned or derelict, or indicate such other specific grounds on which seizure of the vessel is challenged.

You may be cited for possession of a derelict vessel if you fail to remedy the derelict condition of the vessel by the seizure date and time above.

You also may be cited for failure to remove an abandoned vessel if you fail to move the vessel to a place where the vessel can be lawfully kept by the seizure date and time above.
