

Port of Astoria – Invitation to Bid

Sealed bids for the Port of Astoria FY2024-25 East Basin Marina Causeway Removal project will be received by Matt McGrath, Deputy Director at Port Administrative Offices located at 422 Gateway Avenue, Suite 100, Astoria, OR 97103, through Wednesday, October 16th, 2024, at 3 p.m. No bids will be accepted after this time. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud on Wednesday, October 16th, 2024 at 5 p.m. at the Port Administrative Offices located at 422 Gateway Avenue, Suite 100, Astoria, Oregon, 97103.

The work for this project consists of the removal of failing pier structure at the East Basin Marina. The complete Invitation to Bid package may be found on the Port's website at:

All bidders shall comply with the provision of ORS 279C.800-870 (workers on public works to be paid not less than prevailing rate of wage for projects over \$50,000). Contractors submitting bids are required to be registered with the Construction Contractor's Board.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 24th, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. Attendees are to meet at the public boat launch at the East Mooring Basin. The entrance is located at the intersection of 36th Street and Leif Erickson Dr.

Bids submitted by bidders who have not attended a mandatory pre-bid meeting will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.

Bid security in the amount of 10% of the bid must accompany each bid in accordance with the instructions to bidders. The owner reserves the right to reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may reject, for good cause, any or all bids upon a finding of the owner that it is in the public interest to do so in accordance with ORS 279C.395. The owner reserves the right to waive any bid irregularities or informalities.
