RE: Post-seizure notice for F/V COLDSTREAM DOC.# 295013

Dear Todd Cannon,

The Port of Astoria seized a 1964 Wood Hull Fishing vessel, 49 feet 1 inch in length, with a Doc. # 295013 on February 24, 2023, at 5:00pm at the Port of Astoria Pier 3 Boatyard. The vessel contained no personal property. The United States of America Certificate of Documentation indicates that you are the current owner of this vessel. The vessel was seized under authority of ORS 830.911 as a derelict and abandoned vessel due being left at the West Basin without authorization and payment for the slip and the vessel having to be hauled out of the water due to the vessel taking on water.

You, as owner of this boat, are liable for salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs incurred by the Port of Astoria. The costs to date are \$ 35,418.81 for the towing and storage of the boat. Estimated demolition and waste hauling costs are an additional \$ 40,000.00 for a total estimated cost of \$ 75,418.81.

You may immediately reclaim the boat by presenting proof of identification and payment of costs that have accrued. Furthermore, you must provide proof that you can move the boat to a place where the boat can be lawfully kept.

Failure to reclaim the boat and pay the costs of salvage, towing, and storage by **April 1, 2023, at 5:00 pm** will cause the title to the boat and all personal property found in the boat to be vested with the Port of Astoria. Port of Astoria may then sell or otherwise dispose of the boat. If the boat is sold, the liability imposed under ORS 830.938 shall be reduced by the net proceeds of the sale. The costs incurred you as the owner will remain liable for any outstanding salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs.

You may request a hearing by submitting a written request no later than **March 11, 2023**, to the Port of Astoria 10 Pier 1 Suite 102 Astoria OR. 97103. The request for hearing must include a statement of the specific grounds on which the seizure is challenged and whether you challenge the reasonableness of any salvage, towing or storage costs incurred by the Port of Astoria.
