RE: Post-seizure notice for Forest River Cargo Trailer

Dear Orion Carlson,

The Port of Astoria seized Forest River Cargo Trailer VIN#5NHUVH013ET622329; on September 13th at 3:00 PM at the Port of Astoria boatyard.

Our records indicate that you are the current owner of this trailer. The trailer was seized under authority of ORS 819.555 as a derelict and abandoned vehicle due to being left at the boatyard without authorization and payment for the inactive storage area.

You, as owner of this trailer, are liable for salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs incurred by the Port of Astoria. The costs to date are \$961.47 for the storage.

You may immediately reclaim the vehicle by presenting proof of identification and payment of costs that have accrued. Due to carrying a continual owing balance you will be required to keep a credit card on file for autopay at the end of each billing month or be pre-paid a month in advance at all times. Furthermore, you must provide proof that you can move the trailer to a place where the trailer can be lawfully kept.

Failure to reclaim the trailer and pay all the costs of salvage, towing, and storage by **October 9th at 3:00 PM** will cause the title to the trailer and all personal property found in the trailer to be vested with the Port of Astoria. The port may then sell or otherwise dispose of the trailer. If the trailer is sold, the liability imposed under ORS 830.938 shall be reduced by the net proceeds of the sale. The costs incurred will be paid to the port, however, you, as the owner, will remain liable for any outstanding salvage, towing, storage and disposal costs.

You may request a hearing by submitting a written request no later than **October 20th at 3:00 PM** to the Port of Astoria 422 Gateway Avenue Suite 100 Astoria OR 97103. The request for hearing must include a statement of the specific grounds on which the seizure is challenged and whether you challenge the reasonableness of any salvage, towing or storage costs incurred by the Port of Astoria and the Oregon State Marine Board.
